### **GHANA POULTRY PROJECT (GPP)**

GPP is a USDA sponsored programme that aim to provide assistance to domestic poultry production. Under the project about 502 domestic fowls have been vaccinated against Newcastle disease in poultry. 40 farmers were trained in biosecurity under the project. The project supported the Department of Agriculture with a table top fridge for vaccine storage.

Again 11 field officers were trained to provide first aid veterinary services to farmers in their operational areas. Various items were presented to them to enable them carry out this task. The items includes bicycles, feed, vaccine carrier, dewormer, I<sub>2</sub> vaccine, field coat, rain coat and antibiotics

#### **GREEN GHANA PROJECT**

Under the Green Ghana Programme, the government through the Forestry Commission provided free seedlings to schools, farmers and the general public.

A target of 10 ten million trees was to be planted in Ghana to save the depleting forest reserves.

The Department of Agriculture received Cashew, Accassia and Mahogany seedlings to be distributed to farmers, schools and the general public.

1,000 Cashew seedlings, 4,000 Accassia seedlings and 4,000 mahogany seedlings were received.

#### WORLD VISION IMPROVED FEEDING PRACTICES FOR THE FIRST 1000 DAYS

World Vision Ghana is implementing a grant project dubbed "Improved Feeding Practices for the First 1000 Days project" funded by Japan Social Development Fund (JSDF)/World Bank. The project operates with Development Objective (PDO) of improving feeding practices among 5,520 targeted women of reproductive age (including pregnant and lactating women) and 4,900 children under two (dubbed \"first 1,000 days of life\")

#### **PRODESOP**

Promoting Access of Indigenous People to Decent Work and Social Protection (PRODESOP) is an NGO into ginger production and processing.

The NGO is into production of ginger as well as processing. Concentration is on production and processing of organic ginger. Through the support of the district assembly, the company has secured about 100 acres of land which has been given to poor farmers to cultivate the ginger and sell to the factory for their livelihood improvement.

It aims to improve ginger production, thereby creating employment for the people in the Kintampo South District.

Attached to the factory which has a ginger washing facility, processing centre and administration block. There is a separate facility for fish nurseries, hatchery and processing.

The project is funded by the European Union (EU) and implemented by the Centre for Local Governance Advocacy (CLGA), National Association of Local Authorities of Ghana (NALAG), Centre of Prosperity Interest Organization (COPIO) and the Abrono Organic farming Project (ABOFAP).
